

The Yeongdo Harmony Cultural Park is opened

The Yeongdo Harmony Cultural Park, which will be the leader of Yeongdo's cultural Renaissance, finally had an opening on October 19 with the mayor, the Chairman of National Assembly Kim, Hyeong Oh the Busan Administration Mayor Yeong-gil Bae, the Chairman of District Assembly Yun, Ho Gil U.S. Senator Ho-Beom Shin and 5,000 local residents. As an opening ceremony, various cultural events performed until the end of October, such as exhibition for the Korean-American sculptor Ahn, Hyong Nam a musical Gala concert, and 7080 concerts.

Approximately 290 billion won was spent for this Yeongdo Harmony Cultural Park on the area of 27,236㎡ and there are various facilities, such as cultural arts center, library, national sports center, forest park, rooftop garden, ponds, trails and etc.

A birth of Yeongdo Harmony Cultural Park is a sign of Yeongdo being the true 'culture. Physical city' and have a monumental meaning to raise the cultural pride of residents. Now, Yeongdo is not a frontier of the culture but the center of the culture. We're expecting a splendid 'flowers of culture' in Yeongdo.

works will be selected through preliminary examination and will select the grand prize (1 person), an award of excellent (2 persons), and an award of encouragement (3 persons) by final examination after citation.

The Yeongdo Golden Bell was in a type of O, X quiz, where participants were asked questions of history and culture of Busan and Yeongdo by Jeong-suk Lee, a committee member of International Exchange Conference.

For a final result, Yeong-mi Choi from China received the grand prize, Wening Ju from China and Aungyowe from Myanmar received the award of excellent, and Nuentiti and Pamibe from Vietnam and Ji-Yeong Jung from China received the award of encouragements.' with elementary, jr. high and high school students to develop a globally talented human resources.

'Recharging' the Hope pedal at Taejongdae Close the Hangang~Nakdonggang Bike Festival



On October 17, 160 bicycles have marched back to back toward Taejongdae from the gateway of Namhang Bridge.

This was a scene of all of the participants and Busan Bike Hobbysts moving to the Taejongdae Public Garden, to

celebrate the closing ceremony of 'Hangag~Nakdonggang Bike Festival, Hope Petal 2009', which was held with a will to create an environment-friendly green city through a low-carbon bicycling, from Namhang Bridge, where the opening ceremony was held.

They have biked 10kms from Namhang Bridge-Yeongseon Lower intersection-Bando Bora Apartment entrance-Isongdo crossroads-75 Square-Jungri-Taejong Arirang-Haripae overall square-Taejong Public Garden and promoted the low-carbon bicycling.

The closing ceremony held by Yeongdo Life Sports Council had about 2,000 bikers and local residents and had a fusion traditional 'Taryeong' performance, national ceremony, opening declaration, result announcement, congratulatory and welcoming messages, opinions from the representative of the finalists.

In addition, there were various celebration and exhibitions, such as bike shows, bike fashion shows, bike quiz competition, performance by guest singer Se-Hwan Kim, raffle prize, flying

airplane with bike, bike products and design competition and etc and through these events, the bike, an low-carbon exercise, aroused great attention from the residents.

Meanwhile, the participants of 'Hangang~Nakdonggang Bike Festival, Hope Petal 2009', which was hosted by World Walking Exercise Headquarter, have started to cross the country by bike in 7 nights and 8 days on October 10, which starts from Goyang, Gyeonggi to Busan.

office) on October 8 with more than 500 audiences.

This celebration had celebration performance by Yeongdo Female Choir, greetings from the Mayor, congratulatory from the chairman of city assembly and rice cake cutting.

As a special event, the 'History of Happy Yeongdo Academy' was displayed by the 99 guest speakers that have visited and operated a 'message board to celebrate the 100th Happy Yeongdo Academy' for a congratulatory message and for a recommendation of an instructor that they want to bring back.

The speak guest speaker for the 100th event was an actress,

Aengran Eom. Mrs. Eom talked about 'I create my own life' and received great responses from the listeners by telling her own stories with her unique witty.

The Happy Yeongdo Academy, which was established in February 2, 2007 have classes on many different topics such as political, economic, social and culture, for the local residents and the officials at the grand auditorium at the Harmony Cultural Center on every Thursdays (Saturdays) from 3 p.m. until 5 p.m. In addition, prior to these classes, there are 50 minutes long Happy Feeling Song classes at 2 p.m.

During this period, 13,950 people have visited as students in

2007, 12,910 for 2008 and are expecting to have approximately 12,000 by end of this December.

Approximately 700 students attended the lecture of Mrs. Won-ju Jeon and this was the biggest class ever and the guest speaker, Dong-kyu Park, received the highest satisfaction, which was 99%. Our district is planning to operate specialized programs for variety of people such as on-site academy, weekend academy, youth vision academy, and happy Yeongdo residents' association university, based on the diverse opinions from the residents regarding the future operation of the Happy Yeongdo.

The 4th Residents' Self-Administration College have began The 8-week course until November 24 for the Residents' Self-Administration Committee Members

The 4th Residents' Self-administration University was held on October 6 at the Hanbadaho seminar room at Korea Maritime University with 50 people like Mayor, past-committee members and residents' self-administration committee members, to train and motivate the middle level local leaders for local development to form recognition and similarities on development of Happy Yeongdo.

This Residents' Self-administration University will be run the 8 week course until November 24 on every Tuesday for 2 hours from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. with 33 residents' self-administration committee members.

The main topic of the lectures are 'What is Residents' Self-administration?' by Professor Yun-ho Kang from Korea Maritime University and more systematic lectures will be provided by university professors and experts on various topics that are needed for the residents' self-administration committee members such as local culture, leadership, manner and marine environment.

As a guest speaker, a Professor Kang, an expert committee Hui-jeong Jeon from Korea Smile Laughing Research Institute, a Captain Dong-Hwan Chu from Korea Maritime University, a Chief Seong-sik Kim from

Yeongdo Police Department, part-time professor Mi-ae Chu from Gyeongsang National University, a President Gyeong-eop Ju from Busan Minhak Self-administration (folklore scholar), a Professor Gwnag-il Hwang from department of Engineer Informational at Korea Maritime University, and a mayor.

As of Local Governments' Era, the Happy Yeongdo Residents' Self-administration University is aiming to build recognition of Residents' Self-administration and to train a willingness of practice and promotion by strengthening the role of committee members, establishing cooperation within the regions, and forming



community recognition.

In addition, our district have established a personal network among the participants of the Residents' Self-administration University and actively utilizing

the human resource as an advisory role and regional development for the Happy Yeongdo development strategy and Residents' Self-administration.
